

ORDINANCE NO. 68-4

"AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AMOUNTS OF
PENAL BONDS TO BE EXECUTED BY CERTAIN
CITY OFFICERS"

Be it and it hereby is ordained by the Common Council of the
City of Portage as follows:

1. That in accordance with Acts 1905, chapter 129, section
216, page 219, as amended, being Burns Indiana Statute 4-2402,
the City Judge shall execute a bond payable to the City of Portage
in the penal sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), with good and
sufficient surety, to be approved by the Mayor and filed in the
office of the Clerk-Treasurer, conditioned for the faithful dis-
charge of the duties of his office.

2. That in accordance with Acts 1905, chapter 129, section
44, page 219, being Burns Indiana Statute 48-1244, and Acts 1949,
chapter 84, section 1, page 216, being Burns Indiana Statute
49-106a, the following city officers shall execute a bond payable
to the City of Portage in the penal sum indicated with good and
sufficient surety, to be approved by the Mayor and filed and
recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Porter County,
Indiana, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of
their respective offices and for the payment to the proper person
of moneys received by them in the performance of their respective
offices:

- A. Clerk-Treasurer. \$25,000.
- B. City Attorney. 5,000.
- C. City Engineer. 5,000.
- D. Fire Department Chief. 5,000.
- E. Building Commissioner. 5,000.

3. The bonds required herein shall be filed within ten(10)

 "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AMOUNTS OF

Be it and it hereby is ordained by the Common Council of the City of Portage as follows:

1. That in accordance with Acts 1903, chapter 122, section 210, page 219, as amended, being Burns Indiana Statute 4-2402, the City Judge shall execute a bond payable to the City of Portage in the penal sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), with good and sufficient surety, to be approved by the Mayor and filed in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer, conditioned for the faithful discharge of the duties of his office.

2. That in accordance with Acts 1903, chapter 122, section 44, page 219, being Burns Indiana Statute 48-1244, and Acts 1949, chapter 84, section 1, page 210, being Burns Indiana Statute 49-1005, the following city officers shall execute a bond payable to the City of Portage in the penal sum indicated with good and sufficient surety, to be approved by the Mayor and filed and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Porter County, Indiana, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of their respective offices and for the payment to the proper person of moneys received by them in the performance of their respective

offices:

- A. Clerk-Treasurer \$25,000.
- B. City Attorney 5,000.
- C. City Engineer 5,000.
- D. Fire Department Chief 5,000.
- E. Building Commissioner 5,000.


The bonds required herein shall be filed within ninety days.

5. Approval by the Mayor, when given, of all such bonds as are required herein shall be endorsed upon the face of such bond.

6. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage.


