January 1, 1960.

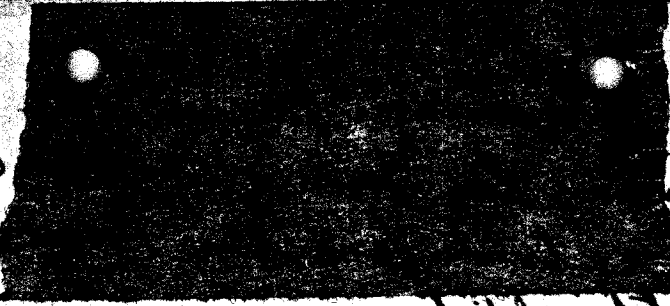
