"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF THE
CITY OF PORTAGE, INDIANA, LIMITING
PARKING OF VEHICLES DURING SNOW
REMOVAL."

Be it and it hereby is ordained by the Common Council of
the City of Portage, Indiana, as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle
for a period of time longer than five (5) minutes for loading and
unloading persons or passengers or thirty (30) minutes for loading
or unloading property at any time after snow begins to fall and
the snow on the streets exceeds two (2) inches in depth. Said
parking restrictions shall continue during snow removal operations
until said operations are completed on the following streets:

All streets of the City except: County Line, Blake, Dombey,
Marquette, Willowdale, Swanson, Monnier, Willowcreek, Crisman,
Hamstrom, Airport, Samuelson, McCool, Stone, Mulberry, Central,
Evergreen, Clem, Old Porter, Portage, and Lenburg.

2. The members of the Police Department are hereby author-
ized to remove such vehicle as may be part as contrary to the
provisions of this Ordinance, or cause the same to be removed and
impounded.

3. The removal and impounding of such vehicles shall be
accomplished with reasonable care; but otherwise it shall be at
the risk of the owner or his agent or representative, and the ex-
pense resulting from such removal and storage of such vehicles
shall be borne by the owner or his agent or representative.

4. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance
shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined
in a sum of not less than Two (\$2.00) Dollars or more than Three

parking restrictions shall continue during snow removal operations

provisions of this Ordinance, or cause the same to be removed and
impounded.

3. The removal and impounding of such vehicles shall be
accomplished with reasonable care; but otherwise it shall be at
the risk of the owner or his agent or representative, and the ex-
pense resulting from such removal and storage of such vehicles
shall be borne by the owner or his agent or representative.

4. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance
shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined
a sum of not less than Two (\$2.00) dollars or more than Three

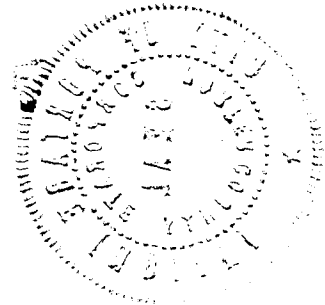

Section 1: Section 1 of said Ordinance is hereby deleted and repealed and the following section is inserted therefore:



ORDINANCE NO. 90-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORTAGE LIMITING
PARKING OF VEHICLES DURING SNOW REMOVAL AND
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 68-12.

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Portage, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. Repealer. Ordinance No. 68-12 entitled, "An Ordinance of the City of Portage, Indiana, Limiting Parking of Vehicles During Snow Removal" is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Parking During Snow Removal. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on the paved or travelled portion of any street within the City of Portage for a period of time longer than five (5) minutes for loading and unloading persons or passengers or thirty (30) minutes for loading or unloading property at any time after snow begins to fall and the snow on the streets exceeds two (2") inches in depth.

Section 3. Penalty. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined the sum of not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars, but no more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars. Each day such violation shall occur or continue shall be considered a separate offense. In addition, the Portage Police Department shall remove and impound any vehicle parked on the street in violation of this Ordinance. The owner of a vehicle so removed and impounded shall, in addition to any fine imposed under this Section, be financially responsible for the expenses incurred in the removal and storage of his vehicle.

Section 4. Conflicting Ordinances. Any Ordinance or provision of any Ordinance of the City of Portage or of the Municipal Code of the City of Portage in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of the Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

The removal and impounding of such vehicles shall be accomplished with reasonable care; but otherwise it shall be at the risk of the owner or his agent or representative, and the expense resulting from such removal and storage of such vehicles shall be borne by the owner or his agent or representative.

4. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in a sum of not less than Two Hundred Dollars or more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars.

5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
