ORDINANCE NO. 68-35

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORTAGE, INDIANA, ESTABLISHING A CUMULATIVE BUILDING AND SINKING FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLANNING, ERECTING, REMODELING, EXTENDING OR REPAIRING OF SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANTS AND SEWERS TO CONVEY SANITARY SEWAGE TO SUCH PLANTS AND/OR FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF STORM SEWERS AND THE REMODELING, REPAIRING OR EXTENSION OF SAME."

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted July 15, 1968, the Common Council of the City of Portage proposed the establishment of a cumulative building and sinking fund for the purpose of planning, erecting, remodeling, extending or repairing of sewage disposal plants and sewers to convey sanitary sewage to such plants and/or for the construction of storm sewers and the remodeling, repairing or extension of same, and

WHEREAS, hearing on the establishment of said cumulative fund was set for the 29th day of July, 1968, and

WHEREAS, the taxpayers of said city were given notice of such hearing as required by law, and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held on the 29th day of July, 1968, and

WHEREAS, no remonstrance to the establishment of said cumulative fund has been filed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Portage, Indiana, as follows:

1. That there be established a cumulative building and sinking fund for the purpose of planning, erecting, remodeling, extending or repairing of sewage disposal plants and sewers to convey sanitary sewage to such plants and/or for the

1. That there be established a cumulative building

ing, extending or repairing of sewage disposal plants and sewers

to convey sanitary sewage to such plants and/or for the

2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval of the State Board of Tax Commissioner as required by law.



RESOLUTION No. 68-10

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Portage, Indiana, as follows:

That pursuant to authority conferred upon municipal corporations by the Indiana General Assembly, Acts of 1967, Chapter 146, Section 1, the Common Council of the City of Portage does hereby resolve to establish a cumulative building and sinking fund~~s~~, for the planning, erection, remodeling and extension or repairing of sewage disposal plants and sewers to convey sanitary sewage to such plants and/or for the construction of storm sewers and the remodeling, repairing or extension of the same and to levy an additional tax at the rate of ^{ten} ~~thirty~~ cents ^{10¢} ~~(30¢)~~ on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of taxable property in the City of Portage, Porter County, Indiana, to provide the funds for said cumulative fund, said tax to be first levied in the year 1968, payable in 1969, and annually thereafter for twelve (12) years.

That the Common Council does hereby set the 29th day of July, 1968, at 7:30 P.M., as the date and time for a public hearing to be held on the establishment of the foregoing cumulative fund, said public hearing to be had before the Common Council takes final action in this matter; that the Clerk-Treasurer shall cause notice of said public hearing to be given according to law.
